

Nauti Girls Fishing Tournament Rules

Date: October 10, 2026

FISHING: This is an ALL-LADY ANGLER TOURNAMENT. Federal, State & County Fishing Laws apply to each angler that chooses to compete in this tournament.

ENTRY FEE: \$75 per ADULT LADY angler. \$75 per YOUTH angler.

SAFETY: SAFETY IS ALWAYS FIRST. Safety is paramount. Captains are responsible for the safe and legal operation of their boats at all times.

QUALIFYING FISH: Fish eligible for this tournament are SLOT REDFISH, SLOT TROUT, and LADYFISH. Fish must be caught on a hook and line and landed in whole condition by a lady angler. Fish must be of legal length, bag and possession limits. Weighing in a fish that is not of legal limits will result in disqualification from the ENTIRE tournament. In case of a tie, the earliest fish weighed will win. Mutilated fish will not be counted. Boat Boys are permitted on the boat but cannot fish.

SLOT REDFISH 18" to 27"

SLOT TROUT 15" to 19" – no over-slot trout will be weighed

LADYFISH – no size limit

START: Lines can go into the water at SAFE LIGHT.

WEIGH-IN: Weigh-in opens Saturday, October 10th at Sea Hag Marina at 2pm. Weigh-in will close for all anglers at 5:30pm. **You must be in line with your fish and ticket by 3:30pm.**

AWARDS:

\$1000 – heaviest slot redfish, \$500 – 2nd heaviest slot redfish,

\$250 – 3rd heaviest slot redfish

\$1000 – heaviest slot trout, \$500 – 2nd heaviest slot trout,

\$250 – 3rd heaviest slot trout

Jewelry from Miriam's Jewelry – heaviest ladyfish

YOUTH:

\$100 Sea Hag Gift Certificate – heaviest slot redfish,

\$50 Sea Hag Gift Certificate – 2nd heaviest slot redfish

\$100 Sea Hag Gift Certificate – heaviest slot trout,

\$50 Sea Hag Gift Certificate – 2nd heaviest slot trout

\$100 boat bonus will be awarded to the ladies on a boat that had no boat boy that catches the heaviest trout and heaviest redfish. Boat must be girl-only and a winner to qualify.

POLYGRAPH TESTING: All anglers eligible for a prize are subject to a polygraph test.

PROTESTS: The Tournament Committee will settle any protest. The Tournament Committee's decision is FINAL.
